South Texas Botanical Gardens & Nature Center is one of Corpus Christi's five major educational non-profit visitor attractions, and a leading South Texas nature tourism destination. It is a *Great Texas Coastal Birding Trail* site. A unique blend of beautiful gardens, bordered by native habitat and natural wetlands, it is a hub of horticultural and environmental education activity, benefiting South Texas economy and Coastal Bend quality of life.

Major floral exhibits include the **Butterfly House & Garden**, **Hummingbird Garden**, **Rose Garden and Pavilion**, **Orchid Conservatory**, **Arid Garden**, **Plumeria Garden with Viewing Platform**, **Bromeliad Conservatory**, **Sensory Garden**, and **EarthKind Demonstration Trial Gardens**. A "Walk on the Wild Side"—through protected natural wetland and native habitat—features the shaded **Brennecke Nature Trail**, plus **Birding Tower** and **Palapa Grande on Gator Lake**, **Wetlands Awareness Boardwalk**, and the **Oso Creek Loop Trail**.
