## **Butterfly Decor**

Delightfully themed around "Mariposa Palooza" featuring 70 vibrant 24-inch metal butterflies designed by area artists, a live butterfly release, lighted butterflies, and drought-tolerant Guara plants with tiny blooms like "Whirling Butterflies" on each table. The Butterfly House will be full, and migrating Monarchs likely dining on Butterfly Hill!

Botanical Gardens leadership says the south side nonprofit major visitor attraction hopes to raise at least \$200,000 for current and upcoming additions, plus funds lost skipping this year's BIG BLOOM Plant Sale supporting city watering restrictions.
